Overall Summary

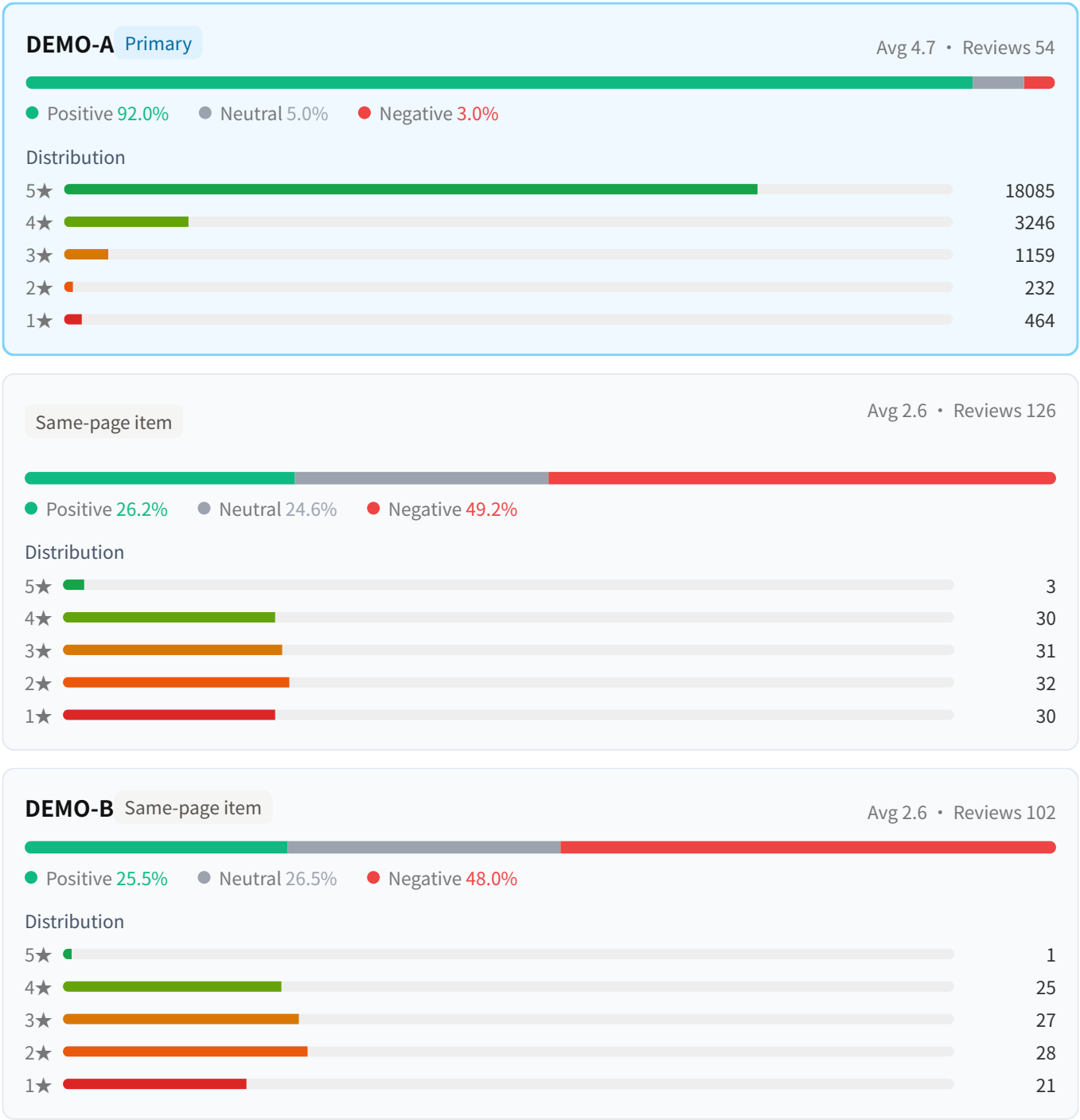

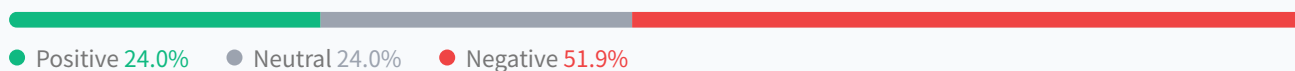

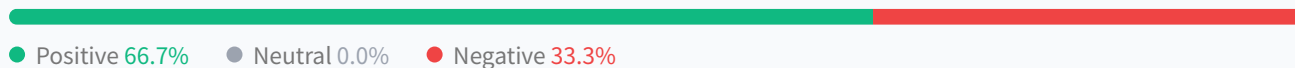
